Any Other Not Addressed: A total of 9 TNCC Provider courses were completed in December 2020 with 105 students participation. Total for the year 2020, 93 TNCC Provider courses have been held in the state with 897 students certified. There have been three instructor courses adding a total of 10 new instructors to the program. The military has had a total of 105 students participate in 10 courses and has added five new instructors for TNCC. For the year 2021, January certified 62 students in 9 TNCC Provider courses. The military held 3 courses certifying 20 students. Instructor cumulative ratings for the 2020 year were reviewed on 109 instructions. Only one instructor fell below the required 3.0 rating in one of the categories. This will be addressed with the individual instructor and the course director.
