# **CEN TESTING**

As many of you know, testing for the CEN and CPEN tests are only available in Anchorage unless they are set up especially for you. AK ENA is trying to set up a CEN testing site the day following the review course. AK ENA feels this will serve those who live outside of the Anchorage bowl. There will be the regular fee of \$360 for non-ENA members or \$220 for ENA members PLUS an additional \$50 testing fee to help cover the cost of this. This is much cheaper than flying in for the test. The regular (H & R Block) testing center in Anchorage can only accommodate several tests per day. We will need a minimum of 14 students taking the test. The BCEN is working with us on this and we hope we can get the numbers needed to make this happen.

### **TCCC COURSE**

#### May 20-24 Las Vegas, NV

The State of Alaska, DHSS Emergency Programs/Trauma Unit is offering a Tactical Combat Casualty Care (TCCC) Course May 20-24, 2013. The Course will be held at JTM Training Facility Las Vegas. These gold-standard programs are designed to enhance and increase knowledge and skill in delivering critical trauma care in the pre-hospital environment. This knowledge is the foundation for mass causality treatment and training. The audience for these courses is physicians, mid-level providers, paramedics, EMT's, military personnel, and other healthcare professionals who initiate life support interventions during traumatic injuries.

The State is offering this course to 20 participants. A grant is able to provide tuition, airfare, and lodging for 20

participants from Alaska, and 4 instructors from the 2012 TCCC Anchorage Course will be Instructing for the course with JTM Faculty. You will be required to attend all 5 days, including travel days.
